



Key Insights: 2025 Nonprofit Pulse Survey

The Community Foundation for Northern Virginia conducted a Nonprofit Pulse Survey in March among this year's Community Investment Fund applicants. Nonprofit services span every area including housing, childcare, food pantries, meals, medical services, education and many community-based services. The survey insights are crucial for donors to understand and support Northern Virginia's nonprofits. Here's what we know so far:



Approximately 50% of Northern Virginia's nonprofits receive Federal funding.



In Northern Virginia, about **850** nonprofits receive over \$2.6 billion in government grants.



Common sentiment shared among nonprofits: sense of fear/uncertainty and waiting for impacts.



62% of nonprofits have **some** reserve funds to continue operations.



Those with reserves would close within the year without additional support.

CURRENT LANDSCAPE OF NORTHERN VIRGINIA



30% of our population experience poverty or low income, defined as below \$120,000 for a family of 4.



Young families find it difficult to afford to live here; especially those earning less than \$150k.



27,000 young people in Northern Virginia experience food insecurity.



From 2023 to 2024, homelessness in Northern Virginia increased by 6%.



There are over 378,000 Federal employees in the DMV; 90,000 of which reside in Northern Virginia.



For the week ending March 30, initial unemployment claims were 24% higher than last year.
