BWGC Education Event: Inspiring Action Through Math - "Counted Out" Documentary Screening and Discussion

Friday, March 14 evening event

BWGC hosted a local premiere of "*Counted Out*," a new hard-hitting documentary that shines a light on math as the foundation of democracy and economic opportunity. The documentary's personal stories revealed how math shapes our daily lives in ways we may not even realize. During the post-screening discussion, attendees emphasized the need for an educational shift to one that prioritizes real-world problem-solving and teaching *students*, not just material. Key action items from the discussion included:

- encouraging others to watch the film
- sharing our personal stories of overcoming challenges
- boosting student confidence through creative teacher training
- creating math camp for adults making math engaging and rewarding
- demonstrating how math and data literacy is important to our daily lives
- developing accessible math education kits
- bridging generational learning gaps with diverse learning resources
- support nonprofits that build confidence in math learning
