in metropolitan Washington, DC since 1985. Despite the routine ups and downs of the housing industry, support for local community is a constant.

Comstock gives widely to an array of local charities throughout the region, but it is particularly proud of one achievement. While the current Fairfax County standard for workforce housing is 12%,

The company has a long history of recognizing the key role that a diversified housing stock plays in a healthy community.
