

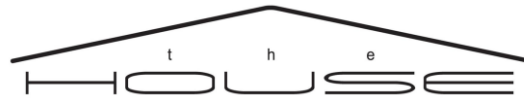

Rosie Riveters: How You Can Engage



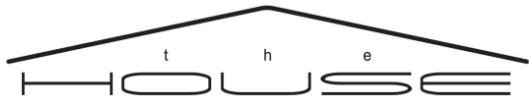
- **Classroom Volunteer**

- **Time Frame:** Volunteering consists of being with us on site for a period of **1-2 hours** (program lengths vary depending on participant age) and you commit to as many projects/programs as your **schedule permits**.
- **Activity:** As a classroom volunteer, you'll get to interact one-on-one with participants, helping them troubleshoot and encouraging them to find their own solutions as they design and build projects based entirely upon trial and error and the examination of an example.

- **STEM Mentor**

- **Time Frame:** Mentors join us at the end of our sessions and speak for about 8 minutes or so about their journey in STEM and participate in a Q&A. Overall, it's about a **25-minute time commitment**.
- **Activity:** Sharing your journey to a career in STEM and background about your field and day-to-day activities.
